- ❖ One-week course designed for TSTC students who have placed in READ 100 or 200, WRIT 100 or 200, or DMTH 50, 100, 200.
- ❖ Quick review courses are listed as READ 0801, WRIT 0801, and DMTH 0801 on the schedule.
- ❖ Classes meet Monday through Friday with one-hour lunch break (on your own).
- ❖ Courses count as one (1) hour of developmental credit.
- ❖ For reading you must register for both READ 0801 and READ 100 or 200. For writing you must register for both WRIT 0801 and WRIT 100 or 200. For math you must register for both DMTH 0801 and DMTH 50, 100, or 200.
- ❖ To qualify, you must register and pay before the deadline. (Check with Admissions at 364-4319.)
- ❖ Classes qualify for Financial Aid.
