## Course Details

- One-week course designed for TSTC students who have placed in **READ 0100** or **0200**, **WRIT 0100** or **0200**, or **DMTH 0050, 0100** or **0200**.
- **Quick review courses** are listed as **READ 0801**, **WRIT 0801**, and **DMTH 0801** on the schedule.
- Fall classes meet **August 22-26**, Monday through Friday from 8:30am-3:30pm, with one-hour lunch break (on your own).
- Courses count as one (1) hour of developmental credit and will be part of your fall course load.
- For reading you must register for both **READ 0801** and **READ 0100** or **0200**. For writing you must register for both **WRIT 0801** and **WRIT 0100** or **0200**. For math you must register for both **DMTH 0801** and **DMTH 0050, 0100** or **0200**.
- Classes qualify for **Financial Aid**.
- To qualify, you must register and pay for your regular fall classes by **August 19**.

At the end of the week (and before fall classes begin), we will retest everyone in the class. If your scores place you in a higher level, your schedule will be changed.
